**2020 QUICK FACTS**

- 1) **Playing is prohibited when:**
  - a) any court or portion of a court is too soft. A court (or portion) is too soft if walking on it leaves any foot impression (get off courts promptly when this occurs), or if a new ball dropped from eye level fails to bounce more than knee high.
  - b) any court bears a "No Play" sign or warning cone, unless the court has clearly dried out since the warning was posted
- 2) **Member Court Maintenance obligations:**
  - a) Courts and lines are to be swept every two sets or when you finish play and no one is waiting for the court.
  - b) Court and line sweepers (brooms) should always be stored bristles up and bristles facing away from the fence.
- 3) **Hours of Operation:**
  - a) Courts may not be used for ANY purpose before 7:00 am.
  - b) Water sprinkler's come on daily at 1:00 pm. Or as otherwise posted on whiteboard. Courts are not playable for approximately ½ hour thereafter (See 1(a) above).
- 4) **Club Access Key:**
  - a) The key provided is used to open the front and back gates, patio shed and the gate by the brick building. Replacements are \$5.00.
- 5) **Telephone:**
  - a) If possible, members should answer phone as it is often a member checking on court usage.
- 6) **Court Etiquette:**
  - a) ***All members are expected to abide by the published Rules and Regulations.***
- 7) **Ball Machine:**
  - a) Members may use the ball machine located in the back shed. (Pressure less balls are also in the shed)
  - b) Ball machine is NOT to be used when members are waiting for court 3, or by junior members under age 15 without parental supervision
  - c) There is an electrical outlet on the fence behind the baseline on court 3. (brick building side)

8) **General Court Use Schedule:** We encourage all members to take advantage of free play with friends or to practice their game. The courts are open to all during the day on a first come first serve basis anytime except when organized programs are conducted as outlined below. Pick-up games are popular events and always casual fun. They are also a great way to meet our long standing and very friendly members!
